RE: Year 5 Enrichment Activities 2019-2020

Further to my letter of 5th September, please see below the enrichment activities / trips that are planned for year 5 this academic year, however this could change due to costings:

Autumn	Reptile Encounter
Spring	Ancient Greek Workshop
Summer	Tudor Trip

These enrichment activities are enjoyable for the pupils and can help them understand and enhance their learning.

Once again this year we will be asking for a one-off £30 payment in order for your child to take part in the enrichment activities. **Payment must be made via ParentPay.** The facility is entitled "Year 5 Enrichment Activities 2019-2020."

If you would like your child to take part in these activities, you should have paid either £30 in one lump sum or have made the first of 3 instalments of £10. The dates these instalments must be made are 1st October, 1st November and 1st December respectively.

When you make payment you are also giving consent for your child to take part in the activities/trips detailed above and for a member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.

If you are unable to make online payments with ParentPay, please request a bar-coded letter from the school office.

We do not have any external funding for these enrichment activities therefore, if no consent and instalment has been made via ParentPay by the extended cut-off date of 4th **October**, unfortunately your child cannot be included in their year group's Autumn activity.

Similarly, if you haven't given consent and paid £30 via ParentPay (either in one lump sum or by 3 instalments) by 1st December, your child cannot attend/take part in the year's enrichment activities.

We hope you will make this one-off payment of £30, to ensure that your child gets the best from the enrichment activities that are on offer and to secure their place.
