We will be learning about:

- Self-registration, routines and our time table.
- Road safety, water safety and self-care.
- How we all travel to school.
- Talking about own experiences - special journeys/modes of transport.
- Following maps around the environment.
- Journeys around our learning environment.
- Respecting others and using good manners. What is right and wrong?

Understanding the World

We will be learning about:

- Celebrations and special occasions – birthdays, new life.
- Road safety- Match/recognise sounds on road safety walk, Environmental features near school.
- Transport from around the world and comparing old and new vehicles.
- Using magnifying glasses, telescopes, binoculars to explore.
- ICT - Photos of journeys: What can you see? My World – Build a town, Roamer, remote controlled vehicles.
- Using a feely bag to describe a vehicle.
- TRIP – Trip to a local farm – reflection from last term.



Communication and Language / Literacy

We will be learning to:

- Discuss what is seen on roads/ safety walk.
- Follow directions, make simple statements.
- Take part in a listening walk.
- Name different vehicles, describe what they are used for and how they move.
- Read and write trail symbols & match to real objects; make treasure maps and story maps.
- Experiment making lists, labels, letters and cards; write last names and friends names, write in role.
- Describe different vehicles and transport and talk about road safety.
- Read stories together such as Mr Gumpy's outing, What Ever Next!, You Choose and non-fiction books about journeys.

Journeys/ Transport: wheels, wings and water



Physical Development

We will be learning about:

- Action Songs – using sign and actions – transport songs e.g. wheels on the bus, Traffic lights etc.
- Outdoors: negotiate obstacles/zebra crossing.
- Walk in the local area, going on an imaginative walk/journey.
- How to follow/draw a chalk route.
- How walking, cycling, scooting is healthy.
- Garage role play.
- Transport puzzles.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Bar charts about how we get to school.
- Graphs for the total number of walkers each day.
- Sequencing / counting/sorting/comparing size and vocabulary linked to these.
- Patterns of our day – when do we make our journeys?
- Money – counting, paying, buying, and booking. Role play as Travel Agents and airport workers.
- Addition/Subtraction/3D shapes.
- Floating and sinking.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to:

- Make models and paint pictures of what is seen on our way to school.
- Make models for around our school.
- Sing songs and rhymes such as, 'Here we go round the Mulberry Bush' and 'The Wheels on the bus'.
- Set up a 'Road way' outside
- Create a small world and construct roads, etc.
- Make marks with vehicles.
- Create junk model vehicles.
- Make prints and patterns with vehicles into malleable materials.
- Role play a policeperson, a lollipop person and others.
