### Our New Class - routine

- **Welcome** - 🎵 Brain gym/ wake and shake
- **Getting to Know You** - new relationships, new friends.
- **Circle Time** - names, manners, rules, values (say something nice about others) etc
- **Feelings** - *Owl Babies*, rainbow fish
- **Celebrations**- Harvest, Diwali

## Communication and Language / Literacy

- **Listening** - following simple instructions, how do we speak to each other?
- **Simple Rhyme**-joining in action songs and rhymes
- **Phonics** - hearing sounds, playing sound games and introducing Read write inc, simple CVC words
- **Reading Development** - simple book skills and talk about the pictures.
- **Stories for Writing** - 'We're going on a bear hunt' developing early writing skills
- **Writing** - mark making and name writing
- **We will be exploring different books and stories (fiction and non-fiction) around families, likes and dislikes and school environment** - Retell, puppets, act out.

## Maths

- **Counting to 10** - number songs, stencils, collage, dough, beads
- **Shape** - shapes in the environment, shapes of our body
- **Matching and sorting** - everyday objects
- **Time** - special events, night and day,
- **Patterns** - clothes, bubbles, using body parts, decorations
- **Colours**- 'Elmer', fireworks and festival decorations
- **Measurement**- cooking activities

## Knowledge and Understanding

- **Weather** - weather chart
- **All About Me** - self-portraits and families, photos, information books
- **Festivals** - family celebrations, food
- **Autumn** - Autumn walk/harvest
- **Designing and Making** - junk modelling, model making and construction
- **ICT**- Using everyday ICT, simple skills
- **Entry point** - wear an item of clothing belonging to your mum/dad.

## Physical Development

- **Action Songs**- Action games and songs, head shoulders, knees and toes.
- **Healthy Routines** -hygiene, keeping clean, healthy eating, exercise.
- Travelling and moving safely, circle games
- **Handling Equipment Safely and Independently** - cutting, spreading, chopping, building and making
- **Finding and Using Equipment** - treasure hunt, label matching game, tidy up time
- **Developing Pencil Grip** - sand and playdough, catching and throwing games

## Creative Development

- **Portraits** - observational drawing, paint, crayons, collage, sculpture
- **Bodies** - chalk drawings
- **Exploring Colour** - water, puddles and bubbles
- **Role Play** - home corner, simple puppets and masks
- **Music Area** - nursery rhymes, recognising instruments
- **Moving to Music and Drama** - action rhymes, wake and shake
